

Hunter Division Definitions

All Classes to be judged using USEF Rules

Must show in all classes in division to qualify for daily and year-end awards.

**Walk Trot divisions may change horses, points stay with the rider.

<p>Walk Trot Divisions (2)** To be shown walk and trot both directions of the ring, and jump one X (12"-18"). Not eligible for any other classes in hunter ring. Can cross enter into Walk Trot Performance classes. Age to be determined by class name.</p>	<p>Pleasure Division Open to all riders, to be judged on performance and soundness. Jumps to be set at 2'. Hunter Hack class to jump 2 fences at judge's discretion. U/S to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring.</p>
<p>Beginner Crossrails (1) To be shown at the walk and trot both directions of the ring. Jump classes to be shown at the trot over four X Jumps (12" – 18"). Not eligible for any other classes in hunter ring. Can cross enter into Walk Trot Performance classes. Age to be determined by class name.</p>	<p>Child/Adult Hunter Division Open to riders 17 yrs of age and under and adult amateur riders 18 & over. to jump 2'6, to be judged on performance and soundness. U/S to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring.</p>
<p>Crossrails Divisions(2) To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Jump classes to be shown either at trot or canter over six or eight X Jumps (12" – 18"). Age to be determined by class name. May not enter any other division.</p>	<p>Bit O' Straw Child/Adult Hunter Classic Open to Junior or Amateur riders. No cross entry of rider into any rated hunter division. Fences 2'6</p>
<p>Short Stirrups Division Open to riders 17 yrs of age and under. Courses will include up to eight fences to be shown at the canter. Riders are not eligible for any other over fences classes with a course. Short stirrup riders may show in the Pleasure Division including the hunter hack.</p>	<p>Junior/Adult Division Open to riders 17 yrs of age and under and adult amateur riders 18 & over. To be judged on performance and soundness. Courses will include up to 8 fences to be shown at the canter. U/S to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring.</p>
<p>Green Hunter Division Open to horse or pony of any age in the 1st or 2nd year of showing, to jump 2', to be judged on performance and soundness. Can not jump higher than 2'3" day of show. U/S to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Simple lead changes are permitted and should not be penalized</p>	<p>Open Division Open to all riders, to jump 3' – 3'3, to be judged on performance and soundness. U/S to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring.</p>
<p>Low Hunter Division Open to all riders, to be judged on performance and soundness. U/S to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring.</p>	<p>M&S Child/Adult Medal (3') Open to riders 17 yrs of age and under and adult amateur riders 18 & over. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals</p>
